

ORDER

It is brought to my notice that several Lawyers are mentioning urgency for listing the minor bail applications relating to minor offences which were in daily cause list of 18th & 19th March, 2020.

It is also detailed to me by the Registrar (J) (Listing) that good number of fresh minor bail applications are pending consideration.

In view of the facts stated above, I deem it appropriate to get the minor bail applications, which were in daily cause list of 18th March, 2020 be listed before the Court on 7th and 8th April, 2020 and matters of the daily cause list of 19th March, 2020 be listed before the Court on 9th and 10th April, 2020 before the following Benches:-

1. Justice Suneet Kumar
2. Justice Siddharth
3. Justice J.J. Munir
4. Justice Vivek Kumar Singh
5. Justice Umesh Kumar

Likewise, the minor bail applications listed before the Bench of Justice Rajendra Kumar-IV will be taken up by the Bench of Chief Justice, except part heard or tied up or assigned matters.

The fresh minor bail applications which were to be taken up on 23rd March, 2020 shall be taken up by the Court from 7th April, 2020 to 10th April, 2020.

The criminal writ petitions under Article 226 of the Constitution of India where a prayer is made for **stay of arrest**, which were in daily cause list of 18th and 19th March, 2020 be also listed before the Bench consisting of Justice Ramesh Sinha and Justice Samit Gopal. The fresh criminal writ petitions under Article 226 of the Constitution of India where a prayer is made for **stay of arrest**, which were to be taken up on 23rd March, 2020 shall be taken up by the Court from 7th April, 2020 to 10th April, 2020.
