## "NOTICE

Hon'ble The Chief Justice has been pleased to pass following orders:-

"In supersession to previous order and in exercise of the powers given under Proviso (a) of Rule 2 of Chapter V of the High Court Rules, 1952, the class of cases relating to offences under Prevention of Corruption Act and/or matters investigated by C.B.I. (except criminal appeals pertaining to Prevention of Corruption Act or C.B.I. investigated trial, matters relating to N.R.H.M. scam and G.P.F. scam), which are presently cognizable by Single Judge, shall, henceforth, be cognizable by a Division Bench." (order dated 29.03.2018)

"Henceforth, all the matters (in the nature of criminal) relating to

Members of Parliament, Members of Legislative Assembly and Members of Legislative Council shall be placed before the Division Bench presided over by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Ramesh Sinha in the matters cognizable by the Division Bench and before Hon'ble Mr. Justice K.N. Bajpayee in the matters cognizable by Single Judge." (order dated 27.08.2018) In view of the above orders, it has been directed that the learned counsel

is required to specify in paragraph 3 of the petition, to be filed in the above categories of cases, that the matter pertains to the above category and/or whether any of the co-accused is subjected to the above categories of cases.
