THE ALLAHABAD HIGH COURT OFFICERS AND STAFF (CONDITIONS OF SERVICE AND CONDUCT) (AMENDMENT) RULES, 2019.

- 1. Short title and commencement: (i) These rules may be called as "The Allahabad High Court Officers and Staff (Conditions of Service and Conduct) (Amendment) Rules, 2019."
- (ii) These Rules shall come into force from the date of publication in official Gazette.
- 2. Provided that the maximum age limit shall, in the case of candidate of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Freedom Tribes, dependents of Fighters and Backward Classes, be greater by five years.
