3. No urgency application is required in fresh as well as filed cases of Criminal Misc. Bail Applications, Anticipatory Bail, Criminal Appeal U/s 14 A (2) S.C. /S.T. Act, Habeas Corpus Writ Petition and Writ Matters pertaining to Arrest/Stay of Arrest and Criminal Revisions filed under Section 102 of the Juvenile Justice Act, 2015 and civil matters pertaining to **Demolition, Recovery and Eviction**.
4. Urgency applications shall be placed before the Bench having jurisdiction over the matter, provided urgency applications in TU/PH matters shall be placed before the TU/PH Bench.
5. The Daily Cause List shall not be printed/published till further orders.
6. All cases where the vires of Central or State Legislation is challenged be listed before the appropriate Division Bench having jurisdiction over the matter falling under the legislation in issue.
7. The Allahabad High Court, Lucknow Bench, Lucknow shall function in accordance with the Modalities and Arrangement during COVID-19 (as issued time to time).
