In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (2) of Article 229 of the Constitution of India, Hon'ble the Chief Justice has been pleased to make the following amendments in "*The Allahabad High Court Computer Cadre Service Rules, 2010*" :-

**THE ALLAHABAD HIGH COURT COMPUTER CADRE SERVICE (AMENDMENT) RULES, 2025**

**1. Short title and Commencement.-** (1) These rules may be called "The Allahabad High Court Computer Cadre Service (Amendment) Rules, 2025".

(2) These Rules shall come into force from the date of publication in the Official Gazette.

**2. Definition.-** In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires, 'Rules' mean "The Allahabad High Court Computer Cadre Service Rules, 2010".

**3. Substitution of Rule 14.-** In the said rule, for the existing Rule 14 set out in column-1 below, the provision as set out in column-2 shall be substituted namely:

<p><b>14. Reservation:</b> (1) There shall be reservation of 21% for the Scheduled Castes, 2% for the Scheduled Tribes and 27% for the Other Backward Classes and 10% for the Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) as per the provisions of the Uttar Pradesh Public Services (Reservation for Economically Weaker Sections) Act, 2020 on the vacant where selection is made through direct recruitment.</p> <p>(2) The High Court may provide any horizontal reservation on the aforesaid post.</p> <p>(3) In case for three consecutive selection suitable candidates are not available in the reserved category then the post may be filled by the general candidates.</p>	<p><b>14. Reservation for Scheduled Castes, etc.-</b> (i) <b>Reservation in favour of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes and Economically Weaker Sections-</b> In direct recruitment to the various categories of posts in the establishment, the following percentages of vacancies to which recruitments are to be made shall be reserved in favour of the candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes of U.P., Scheduled Tribes of U.P., Other Backward Classes of U.P. and Economically Weaker Sections of U.P. as per the provisions of the Uttar Pradesh Public Services (Reservation for Economically Weaker Sections) Act, 2020.-</p> <table><tr><td>(a)</td><td>In case of Scheduled Castes</td><td>21%</td></tr><tr><td>(b)</td><td>In case of Scheduled Tribes</td><td>02%</td></tr><tr><td>(c)</td><td>In case of Other Backward Classes</td><td>27%</td></tr><tr><td>(d)</td><td>In case of Economically Weaker Sections</td><td>10%</td></tr></table> <p>(ii) <b>Horizontal Reservation in favour of Women, Dependent of Freedom Fighters, Ex-servicemen and Physically Handicapped-</b></p> <p>In direct recruitment to the various categories of posts in the establishment, for the purpose of implementation of horizontal reservation in favour of women, dependent of freedom fighters, physically handicapped and Ex-servicemen, the following percentages shall apply -</p> <table><tr><td>(a)</td><td>Women</td><td>20%</td></tr><tr><td>(b)</td><td>D.F.F.</td><td>02%</td></tr><tr><td>(c)</td><td>Ex-servicemen</td><td>05%</td></tr><tr><td>(d)</td><td>Physically Handicapped</td><td>04%</td></tr></table> <p><b>Explanation-I:-</b> The expression dependent of freedom fighters and ex-servicemen shall be as defined under the Uttar Pradesh Public Services (Reservation for Physically Handicapped, Dependents of Freedom Fighters and Ex- Servicemen) Act, 1993 and its subsequent amendments enacted from time to time.</p> <p><b>Explanation-II:-</b> The expression physically handicapped shall be as defined under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 and its subsequent amendments enacted from time to time.</p> <p>Provided that four percent of vacancies shall be reserved for the following persons with "benchmark disabilities",</p>	(a)	In case of Scheduled Castes	21%	(b)	In case of Scheduled Tribes	02%	(c)	In case of Other Backward Classes	27%	(d)	In case of Economically Weaker Sections	10%	(a)	Women	20%	(b)	D.F.F.	02%	(c)	Ex-servicemen	05%	(d)	Physically Handicapped	04%
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	<p>namely:-</p> <p>(i) One percent for the persons in the following category of disabilities under the category of 'Locomotor disability' (as defined in the Schedule appended to the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016):-</p> <p>(a) Locomotor disability of One Arm, One Leg and Both Legs;</p> <p>(b) Leprosy cured person;</p> <p>(c) Dwarfism;</p> <p>(d) Acid attack victims;</p> <p>(ii) One percent for the persons with 'Low vision' under the category of 'Visual Impairment' (as defined in the Schedule appended to the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016);</p> <p>(iii) One percent for the persons with 'hard of hearing' under the category of 'Hearing Impairment' (as defined in the Schedule appended to the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016);</p> <p>(iv) Remaining One percent for the persons mentioned in the above clauses (i), (ii) &amp; (iii), on rotation basis.</p> <p>Explanation:- the roster points meant for the candidates with benchmark disabilities mentioned in clauses (d) and (e) of sub-section (1) of Section 34 of the said Central Act, shall be allotted to the candidates in categories (i) to (iii) mentioned above, in the same order.</p> <p>Provided further that reservation for direct recruitment for various categories of posts in the establishment shall be in accordance with the orders issued by the Chief Justice from time to time.</p>
