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

As per Section 42 and Section 43 of the Consumer Protection Act, 2019 and Rule 3(1) and Rule 6 of the Consumer Protection (Qualification for appointment, method of recruitment, procedure of appointment, term of office, resignation and removal of the President and members of the State Commission and District Commission) Rule, 2020, applications are invited directly or by nomination from among Hon'ble Judges of High Court (Sitting or Retired) for appointment to the post of President of the Meghalaya State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, (State Commission) of Meghalaya.

The President of the State Commission shall hold office for a period of four years or upto the age of sixty-seven years, whichever is earlier.

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

Filling up of the post of President of the State Consumer Dispute Redressal Commission (State Commission), Meghalaya.

Applications are invited directly or by nomination for eligible candidates for appointment to the post of President in the State Consumer Dispute Redressal Commission (SCDRC) (State Commission), Meghalaya.

2. Under the Consumer Protection Act, 2019 the State Government has established the State Consumer Dispute Redressal Commission (State Commission) at the State level. It adjudicates consumer complaints relating to defective goods, deficient service, including unfair restrictive trade practices, where the value of goods or service paid as consideration exceeds rupees One Crore, but does not exceed Rupees Ten Crore. It also hears appeals against the order of District Consumer Dispute Redressal Commissions (District Commissions) within the State. The State Commission is constituted under a President and not less than 4 (four) Members.

3. There shall be a vacancy for the post of President, Meghalaya State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission w.e.f 09.05.2026. It is proposed to fill up the post of President of SCDRC (State Commission) in terms of the provision of the Consumer Protection (Qualification for appointment, method of recruitment, procedure of appointment, term of office, resignation and removal of the President and members of the State Commission and District Commission Rules, 2020.

4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

In terms of Rule 3 of the Consumer Protection (Qualification for appointment, method of recruitment, procedure of appointment, term of office, resignation and removal of the President and members of the State Commission and District Commission Rules, 2020 made by Central Government in exercise of powers conferred by section 29 and 43, read with clause (n) and (w) of sub-section (2) of section 101 of the Consumer Protection Act, 2019 (35 of 2019). a person shall not be qualified for appointment as President of State Consumer Dispute Redressal Commission, unless he is, or has been a Judge of the High Court.

5. DISQUALIFICATIONS

A person shall be disqualified for appointment as President of State Commission if he –

- a) Has been convicted and sentenced to imprisonment for an offence which involves moral turpitude ; or
- b) Has been adjudged to be insolvent; or
- c) Is of unsound mind and stands so declared by a Competent Court; or
- d) Has been removed or dismissed from the service of the State Government or Central Government or a body corporate owned or controlled by such Government; or
- e) Has, in opinion of the State Government, such financial or other interest as is likely to prejudicially affected his function as President.

6. SELECTION COMMITTEE

- (1) The President of the State Commission shall be appointed by the State Government on the recommendation of a Selection Committee, consisting of the following persons, namely:-
- (a) Hon'ble Chief Justice of the High Court or any Judge of the High Court nominated by him- Chairperson ;
 - (b) Secretary in charge of Consumer Affairs of the State Government - Member;
 - (c) Nominee of the Chief Secretary of the State – Member.

7. REMOVAL

- (1) The State Government shall remove from office any President, who –
- (a) Has been adjudged as an insolvent; or
 - (b) Has been convicted of an offence which involves moral turpitude; or
 - (c) Has become physically or mentally incapable of action as such President; or
 - (d) Has acquired such financial or other interest as is likely to affect prejudicially his functions as President; or
 - (e) Has so abused his position as to render his continuance in office prejudicial to public Interest;

Provided that where a President is proposed to be removed on any ground specified in clause (c) to (e) of the Consumer Protection (Qualification for appointment, method or Recruitment, procedure of appointment, term of office, resignation and removal of the President and members of the State Commission and District Commission) Rules, 2020, the President shall be informed of the charges against him given an opportunity of being heard in respect of those charges.

8. TENURE

The President of the State Commission shall hold office for a term of four years or up to the age of sixty-seven years, whichever is earlier and shall be eligible for reappointment for another term of four years subject to the age limit of sixty-seven years, and such reappointment is made on the basis of the recommendations of the Selection Committee.

9. REMUNERATION AND OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS


Fixation of pay of the person retired from the post of High Court Judge, appointed to the post of President in whole time basis, shall be on the basis of the pay last drawn reduced by the amount of pension.

(This is subject to any modification, if made in future, in the pay structure by State Government).

10. OATH OF OFFICE AND SECRECY

Every person appointed to be the President shall, before entering upon his office, make and subscribe an oath of office in **Form – I** and Oath of Secrecy in **Form- II** annexed.

11. Applications of eligible candidates, willing to be considered for the post of President in the State Commission in the attached proforma may be sent to Registrar-cum-Secretary, Meghalaya State Consumer Dispute Redressal Commission (State Commission), D.T.O Building, 4th Floor, Lachumiere, Shillong-793001, so as to reach by 18.04.2026 Applications which are incomplete or lacking in any details/documents as asked for or which are received after the due date 18.04.2026 shall not be entertained.
