In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (2) of Article 229 of the Constitution of India, Hon'ble the Chief Justice has been pleased to make the following amendments in "The Allahabad High Court Officers and Staff (Conditions of Service and Conduct) Rules, 1976" :-

THE ALLAHABAD HIGH COURT OFFICERS AND STAFF (CONDITIONS OF SERVICE AND CONDUCT) (AMENDMENT) RULES, 2025

1. Short title and Commencement.- (1) These rules may be called "The Allahabad High Court Officers and Staff (Conditions of Service and Conduct) (Amendment) Rules, 2025".

(2) These rules shall come into force from the date of publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Definition.- In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires, 'Rules' mean "The Allahabad High Court Officers and Staff (Conditions of Service and Conduct) Rules, 1976".

3. Substitution of sub-rule (a)(i) of Rule 8 of Part IV.- In the said rules, for the existing sub-rule (a)(i) of Rule 8 set out in column-1 below, the provision as set out in column-2 shall be substituted namely :

8.(a)(i) Computer Assistant	(i) 60% by direct recruitment through competitive examination conducted by the appointing authority or such manner as directed by Chief Justice. (ii) 40% by promotion on merit through competitive examination from Class IV employees who have completed five years continuous satisfactory service as on 01 st July of the year of recruitment and possesses the minimum educational qualification of intermediate alongwith CCC Certificate / Diploma / Degree in Computer Science from recognized institute established by law in India.	8.(a)(i) Computer Assistant	(i) 60% by direct recruitment through competitive examination conducted by the appointing authority or such manner as directed by Chief Justice. (ii) 40% by promotion on merit through competitive examination from Class IV employees, including those holding the post of Driver , who have completed five years continuous satisfactory service as on 01 st July of the year of recruitment and possesses the minimum educational qualification of intermediate alongwith CCC Certificate / Diploma / Degree in Computer Science from recognized institute established by law in India. Provided that Drivers selected under this provision shall not be entitled to pay protection according to their previous remuneration in the Driver



cadre and shall be appointed at the entry pay level of the Computer Assistant post.

Provided further that over and above the prescribed experience of 5 years as on 1st July of the recruitment year, the following weightage in percentage shall be given for experience in the departmental examination:

Years	Marks
<i>More than 5 years and upto 10 years satisfactory service over and above the prescribed 5 years' experience</i>	2%
<i>More than 10 years and upto 15 years satisfactory service over and above the prescribed 5 years' experience</i>	4%
<i>More than 15 years and upto 20 years satisfactory service over and above the prescribed 5 years' experience</i>	6%
<i>More than 20 years and upto 25 years satisfactory service over and above the prescribed 5 years' experience</i>	8%
<i>25 years or more satisfactory service over and above the prescribed 5 years' experience</i>	10%


