ROLL OF ADVOCATES [PART-A] AT ALLAHABAD

REMINDER NOTICE

As per information provided by Bar Council of India, New Delhi, rules governing All India Bar Examination are mentioned as under:

“Rules governing All India Bar Examination makes it mandatory for all law students graduating from academic year 2009-2010 and enrolled thereafter as an advocate to appear and pass All India Bar Examination within two years. Therefore, all law students, whose degree of law is awarded on or after 1st July, 2010 are mandatorily required to appear in All India Bar Examination. It is made clear that to ascertain requirement of All India Bar Examination, date of declaration of result i.e. 01.07.2010 is to be taken into account irrespective of year/session of admission or date of conduct of examination.”

It has been observed that many advocates enrolled on Roll of Advocates [Part-A] at Allahabad have not submitted their L.L.B. final year marksheet/Degree with their application form and despite the notice dated 12.10.2023, 03.05.2024 and 18.07.2025, they have not submitted their L.L.B. final year marksheet/Degree, till date.

Therefore, All such Advocates are mandatorily required to submit Self attested Copy of their L.L.B. final year marksheet/degree on or before 19.10.26 in Roll of Advocates Section, situated on Ground Floor of Mediation and Conciliation Centre Building, High Court, Allahabad, so that the applicability of the above quoted rule may be ascertained as to whether they are required to appear in All India Bar Examination and in case they are required to appear as per the rule quoted above, whether they have cleared the examination, failing which process for deletion of their names from Roll of Advocates [Part-A] at Allahabad shall be started.
