3. Priority hearing to those criminal appeals where the accused has undergone more than half the sentence in view of Section 436A Cr.P.C. and the accused is in jail;
4. Priority hearing to matters relating to murder, rape, dacoity and kidnapping;
5. Priority hearing to those cases wherein the proceedings of the trial court is stayed or record summoned; and
6. Priority hearing to those cases wherein mediation is successful.
